Be prepared to pick a new gift or steel one of the white Elephant gifts From one of your friends. This is a really fun event.

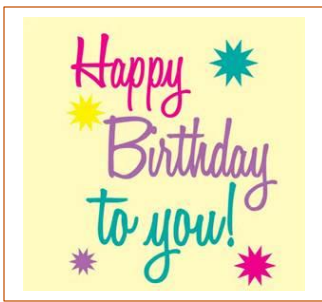

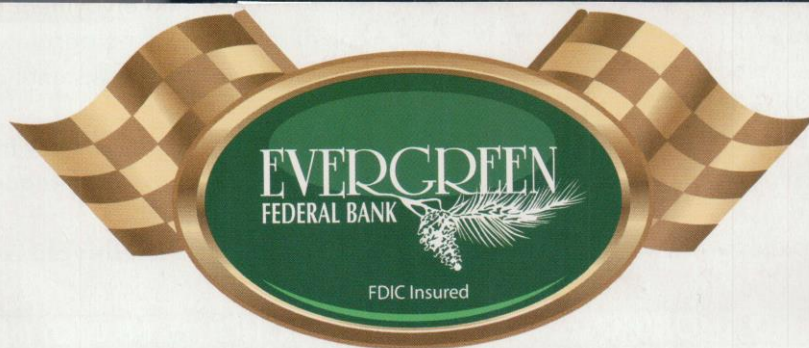
