We had a discussion of the Charity Donations section from our bylaws. "Article VII, Charitable Contributions, Section 1. For each year that RVCC sponsors a community charitable event (i.e., car show or other event), the proceeds from said event shall be distributed to local IRS 501c3 charities which focus primarily on the children and youth of the immediate area of Josephine County (i.e., Grants Pass, Illinois Valley, Merlin, Hugo) and the city of Rogue River. The allocation of monies will be as follows: (a) 80% of the net proceeds shall be allocated in equal shares to three primary charities and an annual RCC \$2000 scholarship (see Article VI, Section 2 for details). (b) 20% of the proceeds shall be allocated during the year to other IRS 501c3 charitable organizations, again, having the focus on the youth of the community...The recipient and the amount shall be voted upon by the members during regularly scheduled RVCC monthly meetings."

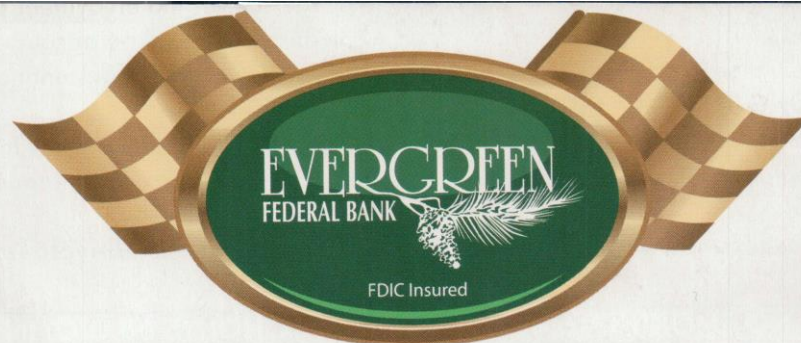
