# **MEMBER PERSPECTIVE**

This month's Feature Car of the Month is the **1966 HemiStang** belonging to Dan Dhondt. What's a HemiStang, you ask? It started out as a 1966 Mustang six- cylinder acquired by Dan when he was 15 years old. A couple of years later he decided on a motor upgrade, to a Chrysler 354 inch Hemi! Fitting the Hemi into the Mustang's small engine compartment required a radical change--everything in front of the firewall was cut off and discarded. Apparently Dan had some serious skills for a teenager and built a tube front frame section himself. He added leaf springs and a 6" dropped axle providing plenty of room to fit that big motor, but then there was no way to hang the stock front sheet metal back on the car. The solution was found in an ad in the PennySaver—a company called Fiberfab in North Hollywood, CA made a fiberglass front end that resembled a Dodge Daytona but would fit a Mustang. The manual transmission originally installed was replaced with a Chrysler pushbutton automatic, but then the car sat, unfinished, as project cars often do. Fortunately, he held on to it.

About 20 years later, his wife Aimee inspired him to finish the HemiStang and get it on the road. He wanted a rear wing to match the Daytona front end, and found one that would fit at Winged Warriors in Texas. Numerous other upgrades followed—flared rear fenders, 5"(!) side pipes with cutouts, diamond tuck upholstery (stitched by Dan), shaved door handles, 59 Cadillac tail lights with a custom rear grill, custom dash with dual gloveboxes and emblems, and more. The teenage dream car is finally completed! Dan and Aimee enjoy taking the HemiStang to car shows like the Fabulous 50's and Roadkill Nights, and just cruising around watching people stare, trying to figure out what they are seeing.
